#### Symposium on Container Design Optimisation to mitigate Pest Contamination Risks (11 November 2024)

As part of the COA initiative to support IPPC (International Plant Protection Convention Sea Containers Task Force), the COA is co-organising a Symposium in Rotterdam on Monday 11 November, the day before Intermodal Europe 2024.

It will be organised in conjunction with the IPPC, the World Shipping Council and BIC. Entitled "Optimizing Container Design to Mitigate Risks of Pest Contamination in the International Containerized Supply Chain", the Symposium will study a range of matters relating to container design, including ways to reduce crevices that are not easily cleaned and might harbour pest infestations.
